Sadly, the family went through some devastating fires in early 2020 which saw the loss of neighbours' houses, schools and some of the town's recreation areas. Some of Marnia's friends weren't so lucky and have had to find somewhere else to live since losing their homes and are trying to find new jobs to support the family. This has been very stressful on the all families and the community they live in, to rebuild their lives, find jobs and build new parks and areas they can all enjoy, all while looking after their children and families.

- Maybe you know of bushland areas where our native animals lost homes? Perhaps you could contact a wildlife group to find out how you could help? Maybe your peer group could build wildlife nest or bat boxes for an organisation that will place them.
